

Who is North End Community Renewal Corporation (NECRC)

North End Community Renewal Corporation is a non-profit community renewal organization established in 1998 by a coalition of Winnipeg community organizations. Its mandate is to promote the economic, social and cultural renewal of the North End of Winnipeg.

NECRC serves the geographic area north of the CPR tracks, south of Carruthers Ave. east of McPhillips Street and west of the Red River. This area has eleven neighbourhoods: North Point Douglas; William Whyte, Lord Selkirk, Dufferin, Dufferin Industrial, St. John's Park, Luxton, St. John's, Inkster-Faraday, Robertson and Burrows Central.

NECRC operates on the principles of community economic development using a development system approach to bring renewal in the North End. NECRC combines four development themes: community, business, employment and housing to maximize the impact of the following initiatives:

- Improving the quality and accessibility of housing
- Implementing employment development
- Creating jobs
- Upgrading commercial and industrial areas
- Improving overall image of the community
- Reducing crime in the community

NECRC is governed by a board of directors elected by the organization's membership. The thirteen directors including representatives from: business (1), residents associations (3), community service organizations (1), aboriginal organizations (1), labour organization (1), religious and fraternal organizations(1), cultural organization (1), directors from any of the above organizations (3) and an appointee for particular expertise (1).

In 1006 NECRC's core funding was provided by: Various ministries of the Province of Manitoba and the Government of Canada, the United Way and the City of Winnipeg.

NECRC defines its development goals through annual consultations and ongoing networking with North End residents and businesses. The corporation works with community committees to plan and implement development strategies in its goal to revitalize the North End. In this way NECRC provides coordination activities and a strategic focus for many improvement activities taking place.
